BÄCHLI TOP BIKE: XL 883 "VIBRATOR" SPORTSTER



Springtime is coming to Switzerland too - end the snow-peaked mountain tops of the alps are greeting from the distance. Celebrating the current "Scrambler" trends with a less expensive Custom modification, this "bare metal style" rough rider was created from a 2015 Sportster. Continental "Twinduro" tire at the front and an Avon at the rear make the bike fit for the narrow country and pass roads in Switzerland - which was exactly where we took the bike for a quick spin around Dietikon!

BÄCHLI TOP BIKE: TWIN CAM GULF BIKE



On request, the Harley-Heaven custom workshop, located next to the workshops for maintenance and service, but fully equipped with all neccessary machines to create one-off motorcycles, can make motorcycle dreams come true: As was the case with the "Twin Can Gulf", which was built for a Swiss collector specialized in Gulf Race Memorabilia and the Steve McQueen racing heritage. BÄCHLI TOP BIKE: ZERO CUSTOMS AND ZERO STYLE



"About two decades ago, it would have been impossible even to airbrush a Harley-Davidson with themes from Japan, but I had the idea already back then", confesses Rainer Bächli. Consequently he is the top dealer and shop for the gooseneck-style "Zero Engineering" Custombikes, servicing some of the oldest "Zero's" in Europe, but also up-grading the stock japanese "Old School" beauties for his clients and creating his very own "japanese custom style" bike projects for the Swiss market, most of which are sold before halfway finished: Here are three examples out of several available!

















BÄCHLI TOP BIKE: SWISS SAMURAI TWIN CAM



Harley-Heaven's own interpretation of the "Japan Custom Style" is highlighted in this brandnew Twin Cam Softail custom, which was created by the Bächli Custom workshop.

Fat Bobber tires to the front and rear, Springer fork and tailfender integrated to the swingarm are some of the modifications that convert this bike into a true "Bobber". Single seat with low riding position and the eyecatching metal flake paintjob catch the eye immediately. It does not need a "gooseneck" to build a jap-style custom! **FULL FEATURE AVAILABLE.**

















BACHLI TOP BIKE: ZERO TYPE 9 APEHANGER



The Zero Type 9 is available in several versions with either Shovelheal or Evo-style S&S engines and Baker gearbox. All models share the unique "multi-link suspension", developed by Zero Engineering to creat a rigid-look frame that nevetheless has a small suspention at the rear end and - of course - the trademark "gooseneck" style stretched front end that hold the springer fork. Harley Heaven's "Type 9" is equipped with "Twin Cam" engine and apehanger handlebar, offering a great ridable custombike! **FULL FEATURE AVAILABLE.**

















OLD SCHOOL CLASSIC: ZERO HARDTAIL 2002



One of the first custombikes of Shinya Kimura to be homologated for European roads, this unique bike is prowling Switzerlands streets since the early 2000's. Lot's of handcrafted details are made by the japanese "Master of Old School" himself who by that time had opened a production/assembly facility in Las Vegas/Nevada under the name of "Zero Engineering". Powered by a modern S&S Shovelhead with "Panhead" covers, the bike features the distinctive "gooseneck" frame with a minimum of framework, "Springer" fork at the front end and almost unchallenged low riding position. Equipped with the neccessary hardware to operate such an high-class one-off custombike in Switzerland, Bächli Harley-Heaven has serviced the bike ever since, accumulating a massive know-how for the Zero brand.

















BACHLI TOP BIKE: ZERO TYPE 5.2



Stock ain't enough for Bächli Harley-Heaven - in particular when it comes to the cool "Old School" rides of "Zero Engineering". Beside being THE biggest Harley-Davidson dealer of Switzerland, the "Heaven" is also one of the biggest dealer for the japanese-style "Old School" Bikes.

The "Type 5.2" Zero is the most radical and finest "Old School" rides available: No compromises are made! The reliable "Big Twin engine is mounted in a rigid "Gooseneck" frame with the long neck clearly visible, thanks to the tiny fuel tank. Japanese-style grahics in metal flake were airbrushed by Harley-Heaven's prefered Airbrush artist.

















BAECHLI TOP BIKE: SPEEDMASTER 883 "DRAGSTYLE SPORTSTER"



Hold your breath! This radical "Old School Drag Style" has not been built for the Dragstrips of the late Sixties/early Seventies, when "Ironhead" Sportsters layed the foundation of what is today's Sportster "reputation". In fact, it is a brandnew 2015 model year 883 "Iron", customized by Harley-Heaven's "Skunk Works": Clearly indicating what the sheet-metal and custom workshop deep inside the Harley-dealership is capable of! Springer-conversion and modified bodywork make this bike a stunning showbike which is ridden in Switzerland!

















BAECHLI TOP BIKE: TIGHT BOBBER



As most other Harley-Davidson dealers, Harley-Heaven at Dietikon has discovered the FXS "Blackline" as a great base for custom projects of all styles. A great example for a "new school" custom Bobber was unveiled in February 2015, whe this 2011 model year "Blackline" was presented to the Swiss public. In true Bobber style, everything has been "minimized". The rear fender is mounted "swinging" with the "Softail" tailend. Tricky idea of Bächli's Custom department: Taillight and indicators are neatly hidden inside the fender strut and almost invisible.

Using the distinctive black/aluminum engine finish as offered in the stock configuration, everything falls into place perfectly with the SCP tank seventies-style metal flake painjob catching the eye!

















BAECHLI TOP BIKE: "HEARTLAND" POWER BOBBER



"Bobber" by name, "power" by performance, this 2011 FXS has been customized to be a real "Street Performer" that is ready to take on any challenger at the next traffic light! Using the distinctive black/aluminum engine finish as offered in the stock bike, black paint and powder coating was an obvious choice! Pure "Street Dragster" styling with a touch of TV-series "Sons of Anarchy", but also some great sheet metal work, integrating the small "motogadget" digital speedo and LED controls perfectly into the W&W Cycle tank. Wanna race?

















BAECHLI TOP BIKE: SEVENTIES STYLE FXS



Remember the Seventies? When customizing was young and metal-flake paintjobs all the rage? And a certain breed of outlaw-riders wanted to shock the scene with symbols of a then not so far ago era? The "Seventies Chopper Style" is back, not just in Switzerland! Huge Apehangers, Springer forks, single seat, straight pipes - but the more comfortable and reliable "Softail" frame in place of the "homemade" rigid frames of the early days of customizing. A great "Seventies Custom" with state-of-the-art technology for todays traffic, new from Bächli Harley-Heaven.

















BAECHLI TOP BIKE: WALZ HARDCORE "OVERKILL"



Having been the Swiss importer and base for "Walz Hardcore Custombikes", Harley-Heaven at Dietikon still is the qualified home to service, maintain and improve the handcrafted Street-Dragsters created in Hockenheim/Germany. One of the most spectatcular - and probably one of the last built - is the Twin Cam powered "Overkill". Outstanding craftsmanship from Up-Side Down fork to single-side swingarm is a trademark of the Walz bikes - this one highlighted with an extraordinary graphics paintjob that underlines the character of one extreme high-end custombike!



















BAECHLI TOP BIKE: MARTINI RACING SPORTY (BY SHAW HD)



The original "Martini-Racing Sportster" was built by South-England based Harley-Dealer Shaw Harley-Davidson and imported into Switzerland for a Harley-Heaven client.

The still legendary "Martini" sponsered Raceand Formula 1 cars were the inspiration for the eyecatching "Off Road" tire equipped Sporty, which subsequently has been ordered by several Bächli clients. Swiss Tattoo-Modell Jesse was available for a spontaneous fotoshoot during Bächli's "Grand Opening", posing for cover- and poster shots.



















BAECHLI TOP BIKE: HD MACH 1 V-ROD STREETFIGHTER



As in neighbouring Germany, all V-Rod models and versions have a solid base of followers for Harley's watercooled V-Twin. They have their own style and the 26% market share of Harley-Davidson in the Swiss motorcycle market grants good sales figures!

Since the 2001 introduction of the V-Rod, Bächli Harley-Heaven has been on the leading edge of V-Rod customizing - using parts from all major V-Rod accessories manufacturers, but also creating own V-Rod components, homologated for the Swiss roads. "Mach 1" is a fine example of a model year 2014 "Fighting Rod" - and has subsequently been "copied" for other Bächli clients in different colours and minor detail changes. BACHLI TOP BIKE: ZERO ENGINEERING TYPE 9 "RISING SUN"
























TEAMWORK SWISS STYLE: HARLEY-HEAVEN WORKSHOPS
